

Useful GIMP keyboard short-cuts

General editing

Undo last change	Control-Z
Redo last change	Control-Y
Copy selection to clipboard	Control-C
Paste into current window	Control-V
Paste into new window (eg to create a new image file)	Control-Shift-V
Select everything (<i>on current layer</i>)	Control-A
Select nothing	Control-Shift-A

Controlling the Image Window

Zoom in on image	+ or Control with mouse-wheel
Zoom out	- or Control with mouse-wheel
Fit image to window	Control-Shift-J
Zoom 1:1	1
Hide / show the toolbox and other tool windows (useful when working on a small screen)	Tab key
Hide / show the rulers	Control-Shift-R
Move image	Drag with middle mouse button (or just use scroll bars)

Note: The image must have focus for keyboard shortcuts to work.

Restoring GIMP default window and tool layout.

If you lose the toolbox, tool options, or other control panels in GIMP, you can restore the default settings:

Edit | Preferences | Window Management

Click "Reset Saved Window Positions to Default Values"

Restart GIMP.
